There is an expectation that students complete all parts of a course's final evaluation.

Please do not plan events which require your student to be absent from school on these days. Students who do not complete their final 30% (in its various forms) do not take advantage of the opportunity to provide recent evidence to demonstrate their learning and growth and to confirm their consistent level of performance and grasp of overall expectations which is used when determining their final grade.

If a student does not provide some significant evidence in the form of a final evaluation (e.g. assignment, lab, presentation, performance task, etc.), it may result in the student attaining a reduced grade and/or failure based on the overall evidence as reflected in the term work and final evaluation components.

### School Closure or Bus Cancellation

- School buses **run on their regular schedule** during these days.
- If an exam and evaluation day is cancelled because of unforeseen circumstances (e.g. inclement weather, school closure), those assessments will be written on the next school day, and all other assessments will be pushed back one school day.
- Inclement weather and school closures can happen anytime, including during exams. We want students and families to know what to expect if the weather or school closure disrupts the exam schedule.
- If ANY WRDSB Secondary School is closed or school transportation is cancelled due to inclement weather, ALL high school exams will move forward by one day.
